

# Oxford Storytelling Schools network

This valuable network supports schools in and around Oxford who are working to become Storytelling Schools. Story coordinators meet regularly as a group to:

- exchange ideas and resources
- discuss problems and receive advice
- receive training on key topics with guest speakers, identified by the group

Meetings are held **six times a year** on the fourth Wednesday of each term at one of the participating schools. Lasting three hours, from 12.30-3.30pm, these are facilitated by The Story Museum team.

A Facebook group for Storytelling Schools participants also provides support and feedback.

The group will have a **maximum number of 12**.
